Law (EA n°4224) leads and coordinates research into Economic Law at the University of Aix-Marseille. It aims at contributing to the analysis and understanding of the legal challenges related to doing business today, in close cooperation with legal experts and economic and social

Consisting of forty full-time Professor-Researchers and more than a hundred PhD. students (a quarter of whom benefit from dedicated funding), the Centre of Economic Law covers every field in business law: traditional fields such as civil law and business contract law, company

Created in 1983 by Dean Jacques Mestre, the Centre of Economic international and comparative law but also more specific economic sectors such as the digital economy, advanced technologies, aerospace and maritime transportation, sport, banking, trading, sustainable development ...).

> This research laboratory is part of the PhD. School of Law and Political sciences (ED n°67) and is a member of the research federation "Law. Authorities and Societies" (FR n° 3076).

Education through research is also promoted through the supporting and coaching of more than a hundred PhD. students, including the organization of monthly seminars, research roundtables, economic law workshops, and the hosting of national and international conferences.

The results of our efforts are that we have around 15 doctoral students submit their theses per year (including 7 winners of the national competitive exam for access to the grade of Professor and 14 winners of the national competitive exam for access to the grade of Assistant Professor for the period 2011-2016).

This publishing activity allows us to disseminate the works done within the Centre (theses, acts of symposiums, collective works) as well as to welcome new publications from other French or foreign universities.

> The Centre of Economic Law also hosts two specialized reviews. one concerning Sport Law (Sport Law review) and the other one in maritime aviation and transport law (Scapel Review).

Our activities

The main activity of the Laboratory is academic research, including a significant number of individual and collective publications: 70 individual or collectively-authored books, 24 collectively-authored special issues, 553 Research papers and encyclopaedia chapters and more than a 1000 case commentaries are noteworthy examples from over the last five years. Among these publications there are numerous periodical reviews in national journals as well as fundamental academic books in civil, commercial, financial, competition, maritime and sport law. The Centre of Economic Law encourages the writing of trans-disciplinary collective books, which brings together all the strengths of the Centre.

Scientific activities are visible through regular symposiums – with an average of ten a year - and numerous workshops, conferences and briefings in cooperation with the Institute of Business Law. Moreover, the Centre of Economic Law participates in research projects with dedicated funding (ANR projects, IDEX projects...)
